

HOW TO MAKE A NEW HOME FOR BABY BIRDS!

Step 1: Find a container and drill drainage holes, if necessary also add holes at the top to secure the nest better

The drainage holes are in case of rain, if you use a flower pot you may need to add extra holes, and if you use a hanging basket remove the self-watering saucer.



Step 2: Fill the container with grass and leaves

If the container is deep place a stick (about 40-60 cm in length) in the container and ensure it's secured to the side so that the parents and baby can climb out.



Step 3: Secure the new nest in a tree

Hang at head height in a leafy protected area away from the sun near to where the baby was found. Secure nest with cable ties or string



Step 4: Monitor the nest for the rest of the day

If the parents do not return by night time you may need to bring the baby inside, read our baby bird poster for more information if this does happen.
